

2025 GCSE Results Performance Tables Success

Wye School has maintained our place at the top of the table for GCSE results for non-selective schools in the area.

The **Progress 8 measure** is not being used this year as a legacy of COVID, but, our last published P8 figure for 2024 was +0.35, by far the highest for a local non-selective and 'above average' for England, which had a P8 of –0.03 and Kent –0.14.

This year the A8 figure is being used. The table below shows all the state non-selective secondary schools within 15 miles of Wye School. **A8 (Attainment 8)** is a measure published annually showing the average academic performance of a secondary school. It is calculated by adding together pupils' highest scores from eight government-approved GCSE subjects. A8 Disadvantaged is the same calculation for students who are disadvantaged in that school. 5+ Basics means the students who achieved at least a GCSE grade 5 in English and Maths. EBACC APS is the average point score in English, Maths, Science, Humanities and Language GCSEs, with our 4.29 meaning our average student had a grade 4 in those subjects, which was above the Kent and England average. A grade 4 is the old grade C.
