WHAT IS ENRICHMENT WEEK?

- A Programme of activities which exposes our pupils to experiences they may never otherwise receive, giving them the opportunity to do new and exciting activities outside of the curriculum
- Years 7 – 10
- All students off timetable
- Residential, day trips and in-school activities available every day
- Year 10 and 12 are encouraged to organise their own work experience during this time.

RYE WATERSPORTS: MULTI-ACTIVITY DAY: YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10.

- Rye Watersports will host students for an exciting day of Watersports.
- This consists of 2 hours sailing, 1 hour windsurfing and 1-hour paddleboarding for £50.
- There are a maximum of 24 spaces available in total per day.
- This trip will be offered every day from Wednesday 13th July until Friday 15th July.
- This trip will take place throughout normal school hours, meaning that students can arrive and leave using normal methods of transport.
- Students will need to bring with them a packed lunch and suitable clothing. FSM students will be catered for if required.



CHATHAM SNOWSPORTS: MULTIACTIVITY DAY: YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Chatham Snowsports will host students for an exciting day of Snowsports.
- The day consists of skiing, snowboarding, tobogganing and tubing for £40.
- Students will need to bring with them suitable clothing. Students can also bring a packed lunch or purchase food at the centre, FSM students will be catered for if required.
- There are a maximum of 40 spaces available in total per day.
- This trip will be offered every day from Wednesday 13th July until Friday 15th July.
- This trip will take place throughout normal school hours, meaning that students can arrive and leave using normal methods of transport.



• DOVER CASTLE: YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Students will travel by coach to visit the tunnels of Dover Castle on Wednesday 13th July.
- Students will visit the tunnels for the Operation Dynamo experience, where they will see how the Dunkirk landings were planned in WW2.
- They will also get the chance to explore the castle and the many different stages it developed.
- Students will need to bring with them a packed lunch and suitable clothing. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- The cost of this trip will be £8 including travel and entry.
- This trip will take place throughout normal school hours, meaning that students can arrive and leave using normal methods of transport.
- There are a maximum of 45 spaces available for this visit.



- FOLKESTONE COASTAL PARK:
YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Students will travel by coach to Folkestone Coastal Park to enjoy a day exploring the eco systems of the beach and park on Wednesday 13th July.
- Students will need to bring with them a packed lunch and suitable clothing. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- The cost of this trip will be £7 including travel and entry.
- This trip will take place throughout normal school hours, meaning that students can arrive and leave using normal methods of transport.
- There are a maximum of 45 spaces available for this visit.



MATILDA THEATRE DAY TRIP: YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Students are invited to visit the West End to watch Matilda on Wednesday 13th July.
- This visit will give students the opportunity to see one of London's most popular theatrical performances.
- Students will travel by coach to London and get the chance to have lunch in one of the parks before going to the performance.
- The show will finish around 5.30pm and students will return to school by coach for around 8pm.
- The cost of this trip will be £42 including travel and show.
- Students should bring a packed lunch. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- There is a maximum of 47 spaces available for this visit.



ROMAN MUSEUM AND THE BEANEY: YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Students will travel by train to Canterbury to visit these two museums and take part in a range of different activities on Thursday 14th July.
- At the Roman Museum, students will have the opportunity to handle Roman artefacts, as well as exploring the museum itself.
- At the Beane students will get to experience what everyday life was like for Romans as well as having a chance to explore the gallery itself.
- Students will need to bring with them a packed lunch and suitable clothing. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- The cost of this trip will be £11 including travel and entry.
- This trip will take place throughout normal school hours, meaning that students can arrive and leave using normal methods of transport. There are a maximum of 45 spaces available for this visit.



- DREAM GIRLS THEATRE DAY TRIP:
YEARS 9 AND 10

- Students are invited to visit The Marlowe theatre in Canterbury on Thursday 14th July.
- Students will participate in an activity at school in the morning prior to travelling to Canterbury by train. Here they will have lunch in one of the parks before going to the performance. The show will finish around 5.30pm and students will return to Wye by train for around 6.15pm.
- The cost of this trip will be £30 including travel and show.
- Students should bring a packed lunch. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- There is a maximum of 21 spaces available for this visit.



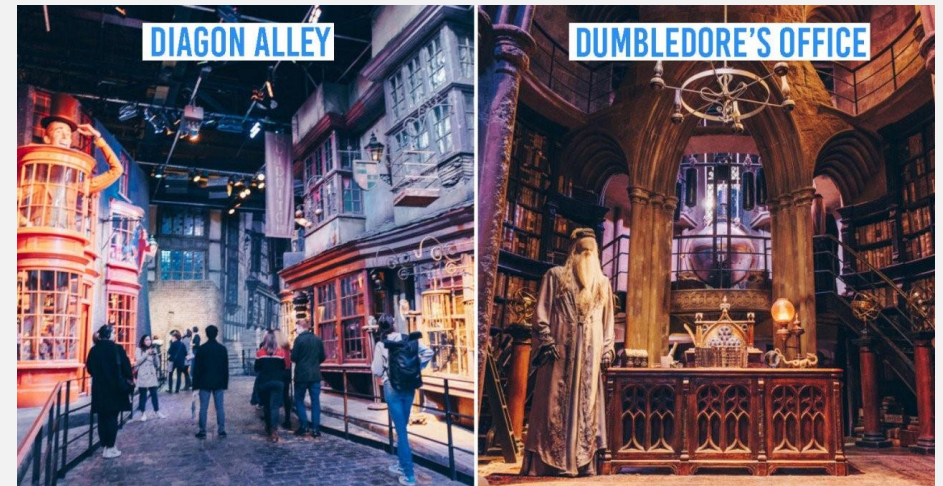
• DAY TRIP TO PORT LYMPNE ZOO: YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Students will be transported by coach to Port Lympne Zoo on Thursday 14th July.
- Here they will be able to observe the animals and will also take part in a gorilla talk. In addition to seeing the animals, students will be able to take part in the Port Lympne safari and a gorilla talk, all included in the cost.
- The cost of this day trip will be £26 which will include travel and entrance.
- Students should bring a packed lunch. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- Students may also bring some money to purchase memorabilia and gifts from the shop.
- This trip will take place throughout normal school hours, meaning that students can arrive and leave using normal methods of transport. There are a maximum of 45 spaces available for this visit.



HARRY POTTER STUDIOS TOUR: YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Students can go behind the scenes to Warner Bros' Harry Potter Studio Tour on Friday 15th July.
- Packed with an excellent range of behind-the-scenes experiences.
- A fantastic opportunity for fans of books and films to tour behind the scenes and walk-through iconic locations like Diagon Alley, the Great Hall, and the Forbidden Forest.
- Students will travel by coach to the studios. Due to the distance, the coach will return to Wye School at approximately 7.30 pm, parents/carers must be able to collect their child from school around that time.
- The cost of this trip will be approximately £40 including travel and the tour.
- Students should bring a packed lunch. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- There are 45 spaces available for this visit.



- SCIENCE MUSEUM, LONDON DAY TRIP:
YEARS 7, 8, 9 AND 10

- Students are invited to visit the Science Museum on Friday 15th July. This visit will give students the opportunity to see one of London's most popular museums.
- Students will travel by coach to London and spend the day exploring the science museum and all it has to offer.
- The day will finish around 3pm and students will return to school by coach for around 5.30pm.
- The cost of this trip will be £16 including travel and free entry to the museum.
- Students should bring a packed lunch. FSM students will be catered for if required.
- There is a maximum of 45 spaces available for this visit.



IN-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

- If you do not choose a day trip, you may choose the in-school activities option.
- Where we are unable to cater for your child in a day trip, due to oversubscription, your child will be placed in an in-school activity.
- There will be a wide range of activities available to students.
- Activities will be confirmed later, but they are likely to include pond dipping, forest school, eco fashion, garage band, martial arts, treasure hunts and many more.

WORK EXPERIENCE: YEAR 10 AND 12 ONLY

- Year 10 and 12 students may choose to organise their own work experience during this week.
- A letter regarding work experience is being sent out to all year 10 and 12 students.
